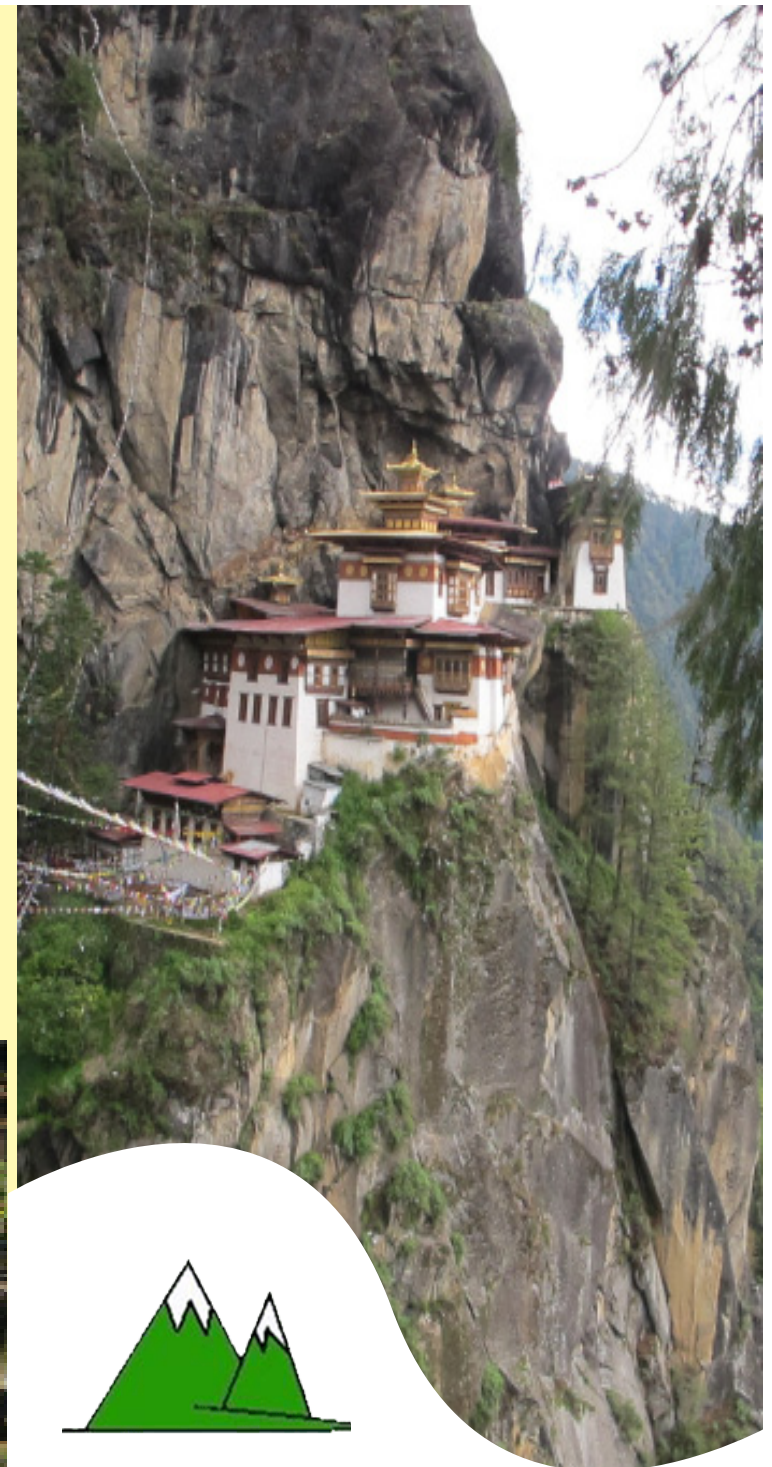
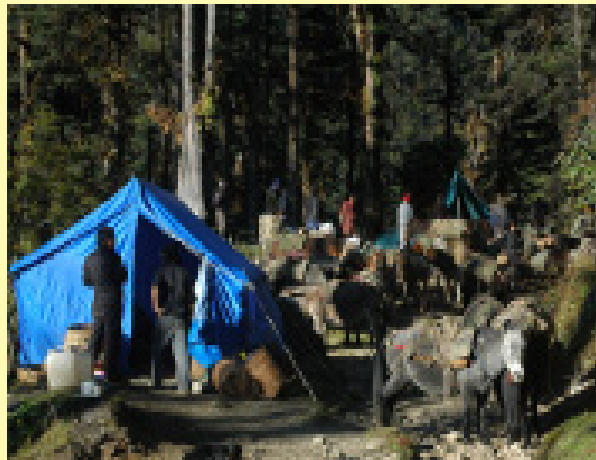

When is the best time to travel to Bhutan?

You can visit Bhutan anytime of the year. Visitors tend to stay away during the monsoon months of June, July and August when the weather is sometimes a little wet and humid for sightseeing. What does it cost to visit Bhutan? The Royal Government of Bhutan sets the International Tourist Tariff, which is valid for all-inclusive packages. The rates are the same for cultural tours, treks or any other special interest package. For groups of 3 persons or more, the rates are as follows: High season tariff: US \$250 per person per night from January, February, March, April, May, June, Sept. October, November and December. Low Season Tariff: US\$ 230 per person per night from July & August. For a group of less than 3 persons, there is a surcharge on top of the daily tariff that is one person: US \$40 per person per night. Two persons: US \$30 per person per night.

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
